MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING to contract effective July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2025 by and between

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is entered into this $\frac{9/6/2024}{}$ by and between the State of Montana, Department of Transportation ("Employer"), and AFSCME Council 9 ("Union") for the purpose of addressing ongoing vacancies in the Bozeman Maintenance Division

AFSCME Council 9

The Employer and the Union agree to the following procedure for the 2024-2025 snow removal season:

- By October 1, 2024, the Employer will determine the number of volunteers required and deemed necessary for snow removal and necessary road maintenance.
- Volunteers who possess the appropriate Commercial Driver's License (CDL) and experience will have the opportunity to sign up according to the employer's prescribed method.
- Volunteer employees have the option to withdraw their candidacy at any time.
- Full-time permanent employees who volunteer will have their overtime worked under this MOU counted as overtime worked in their home field maintenance section.
- Volunteers selected will be paid a performance bonus of \$250 for each week worked as defined in the collective bargaining agreement, in the Bozeman Maintenance Division, with a maximum of \$2,500 to be paid for the season.

The Employer and the Union further agree to the following conditions:

- Volunteers must come from outside the Bozeman Maintenance Division.
- The Employer will have sole discretion in selecting volunteers.
- All bonuses will be paid in a lump sum at the end of the season, or upon termination of employment.

Additional Provisions:

State Office of Labor Relations

The Employer will provide the same performance bonus to those employees who worked during the 2023-2024 snow removal season, based on the same dollar amount of \$250 per week worked in the Bozeman Maintenance Division, with a maximum of \$2,500 for the winter season.
